Dear Mr. Basilico,

At the present time, less than 60 days before the event, we have pleasure to **confirm the status of UIM World Championship of the Hydro GP Classes F125/F250/F500**, to be held in Boretto from 11th to 13th June 2021.

We understand that participating Teams/Drivers and Officials shall be granted entry to the country and access to the place where the Hydro GP Event will take place, without any COVID-19 specific restrictions applicable such as compulsory quarantine upon arrival.

This understanding is based on the regulations of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Health, stating that the entry in Italy is authorized for athletes, coaches, judges and competition commissioners participating in national international sporting competitions. These same participants will have to undergo, in the 48 hours prior to entering the national territory, a molecular or antigenic test, carried out by means of a swab and found to be negative. http://www.salute.gov.it/portale/nuovocoronavirus/dettaglioContenutiNuovoCoron
