Entry details:

All information regarding entries is available from the championship race secretary.

The time limit for entry is 24th August 2012 (10.00 - 20.00) and 25th August 2012 (07.00 - 08.00). Registration is available in the office at the technical area.

Pre-registration is available by 10th August 2012.

All pilots must have the following documents:

- International racing license;
- Insurance policy.

All pilots of F500 must have their logbook.

Age Restrictions:

The age limit for participation in the Circuit World Championships is as follows:

- JT250 – from 10 to 16 years old;
- F500 – from 16 years old.

Insurance:

All pilots shall be insured. They must have and show the organizers their personal insurance policies. If insurance is included in the racing licenses of some National Authorities such documents must be written in English.

Advertising on the boats:

The organizer reserves the right to advertise on the boat in accordance with the UIM Rules (203.051).

Boat classes. Competition format:

The Circuit World Championship in JT250 and F500 classes is a racing event conforming to applicable UIM rules and regulations (please refer to <http://www.uimpowerboating.com> for full details).

For JT250 will be run 4 heats (7 laps each) of which three best ones are to count under a point system by the UIM Rules. For JT250 the number of laps in qualifying heats will be 4 (last lap is safety).

For F500 will be run 3 heats (10 laps each) of which two best ones are to count under a point system by the UIM Rules.

For F500 the number of laps in qualifying heats will be 7 (last lap is safety).

If the number of entries is more than 24 there will be qualifying heats in accordance with the UIM Rules (304.03).

Start and Restart:

The start for boats with engines stopped is in accordance with the UIM Rules (307). The start is open before the first driver finishes three laps. Restart is in accordance with the UIM Rules (311).

Losses:

Any buoy damage is the subject of 100 € penalty to be paid by the driver.

Other terms:

All type boats must be fitted to be craned in and out of the water. Each driver must have for his hull his own set of slings with a joint ring (under crane hook) with a diameter of at least 150 mm.

Protest:

All protests must be in writing in English. All protest must be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted. The Protest fee is 80 €.

Noise Levels Exceeded:

Each driver is responsible for his boat motor not exceeding the noise level within the event time in accordance with the UIM Rules (504).

Fuel:

Each driver must purchase fuel from the Championship Petrol Station which is open on Friday 24th of August (11.00-13.00 and 18.00 - 20.00) and Saturday 25th of August (7.30- 8.30 and 17.30- 19.00). The fuel price will be as regular fuel price on that time on local petrol stations. There will be methanol CH₃OH available for purchase as well. The use of any additives to fuel (nitrite, etc.) to increase the engine power is prohibited in accordance with the UIM Rules (524.01).

Environmental Protection:

For strict compliance with Environmental legislation and in accordance with the UIM Rules (703) each driver must have an absorbent mat to avoid any leakage of fuel or oil on the ground. Each driver is personally responsible for environmental pollution.

Race Instruction:

Each driver receives the Race Instruction from the Race Secretary when Race registration.

Prizes:

The podium presentation will take place after engines and hulls inspection according to the UIM Rules. The race winners will be provided with medals and diplomas of appropriate category. The first six pilots in each race class of the Circuit World Championship will be provided with cups.

Drivers presentation and prize giving ceremony:

The drivers and assistants are asked to wear appropriate clothing at any time, in particular during the presentation of drivers and during the prize giving ceremony. The prizes are given to the winners themselves only wearing their race suit.

Travel/Transportation Costs:

All travel, transportation (delivery of the sports equipment to the event venue and back) and event participation costs to be covered at own expense except as provided by the UIM Rules.

Boat Parking:

Boat parking area is closed and secured. At night-time (22.00 – 07.00) the boat parking area is closed – staying there is not allowed. It is forbidden to make fire and cook at the boat parking area.

All pilots and team members must wear appropriate clothing at any time. Closed shoes are required.

Each team or group will have their space for parking the boats.

Accommodation and Catering:

Accommodation of the event participants and guests outside the sports camp is of free choice. Participants and guests can choose any of the nearest hotels. Refer to the Hotel Information for full details.

Participants and guests will be able to stay in their own trailers and tents at the special area (camp) next to the race area.

Participants and guests will be able to buy food at the supermarkets and canteens next to the boat parking area.

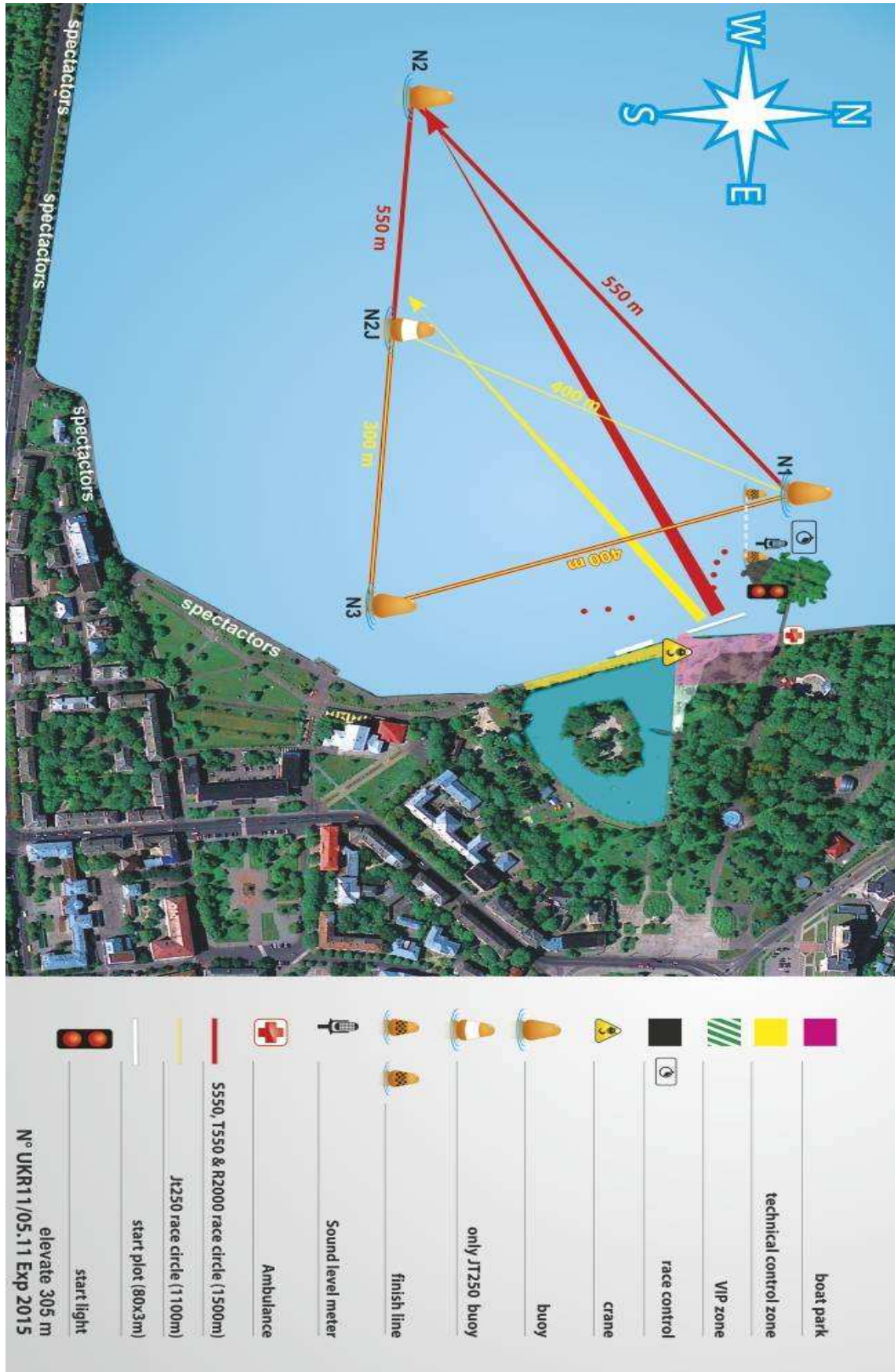
